Garden Visits: Marvia and Brock would like to invite you to visit their garden at 128 Gladwin Rd, about a 15 minute drive from our church. Their motivation is to have more people enjoy the garden. Try to choose a time to come that suits you. As the driveway is gated, visitors would just call ahead – **(604) 859-8591** – with a time range for arrival, and they will fasten the gate open. These won't be guided tours. There are patios on the east side of the garden (shaded by the house in the afternoon), and visitors are welcome to sit to view the mountains and listen to the fountain. Please bring friends if you'd like. If you wish, donations directly to our church are welcome, but they want to emphasize that such are not necessary. One caveat is that they're not the gardeners, so they're not knowledgeable about all the plants. Most of the maintenance and all the current planting and "editing" are by Chrystal of Chrystal's Gardens. She has asked that children and dogs not come. She has experience in B.C. and England. The entrance is well marked with "128" on the right side of the gate post. There is ample parking down the driveway. The driveway and parking are paved, although the driveway is sloped. From the parking, there is a small, packed gravel path that goes a short distance. After the path, on the east side, the lawn slopes and the ground is uneven, so it's not suitable for visitors who aren't well-balanced and steady.
